Webinar on snakes of MP organised

Snakes have been a symbol of worship in many parts of our country. However, the common perception of people towards snakes is associated with fear, which has also led to deep-rooted prejudice in our minds, which can only be conquered through knowledge. They are the most enigmatic group of reptiles because of their capability to do all activities without limbs and the ability to perform all these activities without

limbs has probably surprised people to believe them as some 'Super Reptile', said, Mr. Mukesh Ingle, Herpetologist & Wildlife Biologist, Founder Director at RCRC, Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh, India.

He was the keynote speaker of a day-long webinar on Snakes of Madhya Pradesh: Taxonomy, Diversity Distribution and Conservation organized by Department of Zoology and Biotechnology, Government Girls' P.G. College, Ujjain in collaboration with Reptiles Conservation & Research Centre, Ujjain, under

the aegis of MPHEQIP World Bank Scheme, supported by IQAC. Mr. Ingle highlighted that, although some species of snakes are potentially dangerous to humans, most of them are harmless. As per the present understanding, the snakes of India comprise of 333 species accommodated in 14 families and the



snake fauna of Madhya Pradesh comprises under nine families, he further added. He told the audience that the snake fauna of Madhya Pradesh has been explored and documented by various workers including the Zoological Survey of India and Reptile Conservation & Research Centre. At last, he concluded his

talk by awaring the audience about the myths of snake bite along with its first aid.

Dr Pratibha Akhand, the convener of the program presented the thematic introduction to the viewers and together with the guest speaker resolved the queries of the viewers. She appealed the participants to shed fears and myths about the snakes and try to understand this species better. The programme was presided over by Dr HL Anijwal, principal while Dr Hemant Gahlot, the senior most professor of the college

expressed gratitude towards the guest speaker for pointing special attention to make people aware about conservation of reptiles. Dr Neeta Tapan, IQAC Coordinator introduced the college to the audience.
