

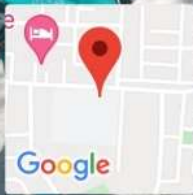
International Cycle Day observed by NCC cadets

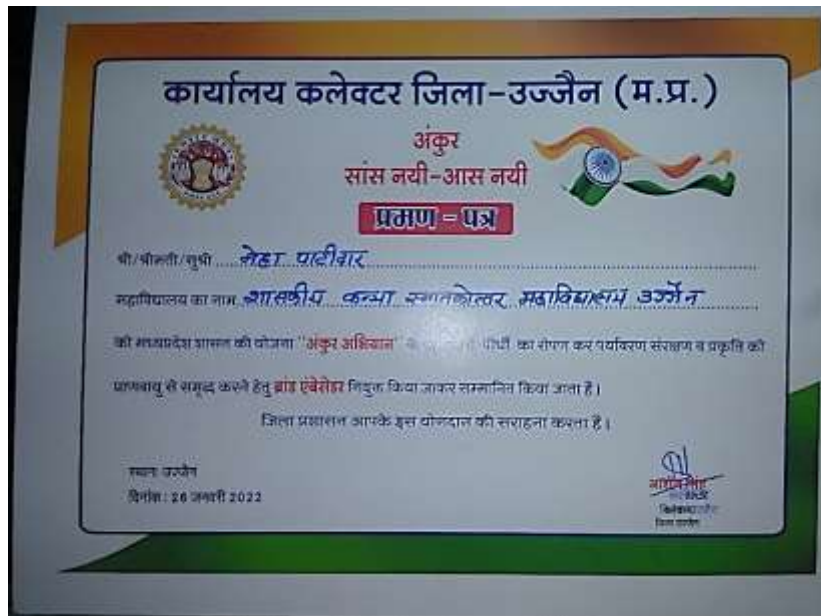
