

On the concluding day of the event on the occasion of World Heart Day, Dr Priya Chitale gave a speech on the topic of heart disease and nutrition and said that heart disease is one of the non-communicable diseases, which we also call non-communicable diseases. She said that heart disease, cancer,

diabetes and respiratory diseases are the main causes of 60 % of all deaths worldwide.

According to the World Health Organisation, 41 million people die every year from non-communicable diseases, which is equivalent to 71 % of all deaths globally and heart


% of all deaths globally and heart disease accounts for the most deaths, which is about 17.9 million. Unbalanced diet and lack of phys-ical activity are the main reasons for diabetes, high blood pressure and obesity etc. These are medical-ly called metabolic risk factors, which if not controlled can lead to heart disease and even premature doath.

death. Dr Chitale said, to maintain heart Or Unitale said, to maintain heart health, greater emphasis should be placed on strategies to control risk factors, including primary preven-tion which takes care of a single fac-tor such as blood pressure or dia-betes.

The sooner we start controlling these risk factors, the more success-ful we will be at keeping our hearts healthy. Dr Munira Hussain resolved the
